1. What is the '3 Minutes Thesis' Competition?

Also known as 3MT, this competition encourages doctoral students in neuroscience and technology to synthesize and present their theses in three minutes.

2. Who can participate?

Any **doctoral student in the fields of neuroscience and neurotechnology** from the NeurotechEU Alliance can participate. You can participate if you are studying in any doctoral program in these fields at the Universidad Miguel Hernández de Elche.

3. How can I participate?

If you want to participate in the 3MT competition, you must send **the application form**, including an abstract of your thesis, **by the 26th of September, 23:59 hours**. Once your abstract is accepted, you will be invited to participate in the online **event presentation on the 30th of September**.

- The form has attached a document related to image transfer and personal data protection that must be signed and sent to neurotecheu@umh before the start of the session on September 30th. There are no exceptions.

4. What does the competition consist of?

Each participant will have **3 minutes** to present their research **the 30th of September**.

- A single **static slide** must accompany it.
- The competition will be held **online**.
- The presentation will be **in English**.
- The link to participate will be emailed to **participants selected on the evening of September 27th**.

5. Is there an award?

The winner will have the opportunity to attend the **Annual NeurotechEU Hackathon, which** is taking place in **Istanbul, Turkey, from 12 to 14 of November this year**.
